



Caring for your Temporary

The temporary is placed to help protect the tooth and the other teeth from moving. They are meant to last for a minimum time until delivery of the final crown.

We do not place them very securely, so that they may be easily removed at the delivery appointment for your crown.

You **do** need to keep the area clean with normal brushing, for the health of the gums.

Avoid

1. Sticky or hard foods
2. If able, concentrate on eating on the other side
3. Floss cautiously and slide the floss out from in between teeth.

If the temporary Loosens:

1. Call the office to have us replace it for you
2. Do **not** go with out a temporary on your tooth
3. If unable to come in, rinse mouth well to cleanse the tooth. Cleanse inside of temp and place back on tooth with toothpaste or over-the-counter temporary material.
