



Limited Dental Warranty

We are proud of the dentistry we provide for you and your family. Our goal is to not just correct the problem but to help you prevent further dental needs. This success comes from your home care and regular visits for preventive exams, digital x-rays and professional cleanings. These preventive visits may be required every 3 to 12 months dependant on your condition. With that in mind, we offer the following:

Dental Sealants

Sealants are protective coatings placed in the grooves on the chewing surfaces of teeth, which are the most common areas for children and young adults to get cavities. Brushing, flossing and use of fluoride can help prevent decay in between teeth and at the gum line.

We will replace sealants for **3 years** after placement if lost or worn.

Composite (tooth colored) Fillings

If composite restoration is the recommended treatment of choice, we will replace or repair it in the event of failure for a period of **2 years**. The only exception is the bonding of the edges of front teeth, which have been previously chipped or broken. If the tooth should further break and require a crown or onlay, we will credit your cost of the filling towards that treatment.

Crowns, Bridges, Onlay

If this procedure is the recommended treatment of choice, we will repair or replace these restorations at no charge for the first **3 years** from placement and at 50% for up to **5 years** from placement. This includes fracture, loss or decay with normal use.

Root Canals

Root canals are over 90% successful, but do occasionally fail. If you lose your tooth within **3 years** of completion, we will credit your cost of the root canal towards a replacement tooth. This warranty assumes that recommended final restoration is placed on tooth, immediately following root canal treatment.

Dentures

We will warranty full and partial dentures for **2 years** after initial delivery if a tooth chips or breaks off denture or a portion of the base or clasp fractures, under normal use. This does not include accidents or dropping denture.

*With all our warranties, you must keep your preventive care appointments or
The warranty is **void**.

We are confident with the quality of our work, and it is unusual to see such warranties with dental care.

You must understand that the success depends on you and the care you take to properly care for your teeth and gums. None of these warranties cover damage from accidents or negligence, and you must keep your regular preventive care visits.
